- Your submission must include take-home messages relevant to practicing cardiologists.
- Graphics are encouraged to enhance your case presentation. Be sure to include them in your abstract if you plan to use visuals.

## Selection and Presentation

- The top five cases will be selected for live presentation during the Residents' Case Challenge session on the afternoon of Thursday, February 27<sup>th</sup>.
- Each finalist will receive **\$1,250 toward travel expenses** (reimbursed post-event with receipts) and compete for the title of best presentation.
- Finalists are expected to attend as much of the conference as possible, including the **Networking Reception** on the evening of February 27<sup>th</sup>. We encourage you to connect with peers and leading experts in EP.
- Presentations should consist of **5-6 slides** for a **5-minute presentation**, including any graphics.
- The winner will be determined by a vote from conference attendees and the planning committee, with the announcement made on February 28<sup>th</sup>.
